



CERAMIC CHARACTER

Thank you for choosing a hand crafted luminaire by Porcelume. The enclosed ceramic shade has been hand thrown and turned on the pottery wheel and then fired to 1300 degrees in order to achieve its unique characteristics. There is a delightful element of chance in the creation of these objects whereby a quiet, yet distinct 'swaying' around the rim occurs during the intense kiln firing process - this is something that we celebrate and is a quality highly prized in Japanese ceramics that aids to further emphasise the flowing organic nature of each finished piece.

CLEANING

The fully vitrified ceramic drum can be removed from the hanging plate/ dowel hanger for cleaning. Use warm soapy water and a brush, rinsing well when finished with clean water. Allow the drum to air dry and then reinstall on the hanging plate/ dowel hanger as per the Assembly Instructions.

(Note that hard wired Bongo and Conga pendants will need to be cleaned in place as they cannot be removed from the electrical flex - take great care to ensure that water does not come into any contact with the electrical components of the pendant).
